

Operation Clean Stream COVID-19 Safety Practices

Remember the following



Cover your mouth and nose with a cloth mask



Practice social distancing from non household members



Volunteer with buddies (household members, groups smaller than 10), or alone. If you are volunteering alone, make sure someone knows your plan (site location, return



Sanitize hands frequently



Wash hands frequently with warm water for a minimum of 20 seconds

Have had COVID-19 related symptoms in the last 14 days (dry cough, fever, shortness of breath, chills, headache, sore throat, loss of taste and smell, or any combination thereof)




Have been near someone who has COVID-19 or live with someone considered high risk


Encounter large groups of people, you can return to the site at another time

Additional Information

Do not carpool with non household members



Always remember to bring sufficient peronsal protective equipment (PPE)



Equipment

Do not share equipment, gloves, litter bags, etc. without proper sanitizing between handlers

If equipment must be shared establish a sanitizing station
